	12 members are the 3 representatives of each existing branch including 4 Branch Chairmen who are automatically one of the 3 representatives.	
	4 Branch Chairmen will be the Vice Presidents.	
	The position of the President, Secretary and Treasurer are to be directly elected with one member one vote.

		3. The Statutory Body shall be managed by a professional team akin to the Bar Council and SLS set up.	
		4. The 4 branches shall continue to exist where each branch shall send 3 representatives each to the Main Committees. The branches shall operate separately and independently to attend to regional concerns and events.	
		5. Subject to the minor amendments to the above, the Delegates are mandated to discuss and vote on the above provided that no one branch has majority number in the Central Committee.	
		2 nd Proposal: To maintain the current delegates system.	
		The matter was put to vote. Majority of the Branch Members voted for the 1st Proposal.	
		During the Extraordinary Delegates Conference on 03.08.2024, it was unanimously resolved for Working Committee on proposed model of the Statutory Body for Sarawak to be setup for deliberation of proposed Statutory Body matters.	
		Our Branch Chairman, Branch Vice Chairman and Branch Secretary are representing the Sibu Branch at the Working Committee on formation of Statutory Body.
